General Safety Information

Children are attracted to and can operate firearms that cause severe injury or death. Prevent child access by always keeping guns locked away and unloaded when not in use. If you keep a loaded firearm where a child obtains and improperly uses it, you may be fined or sent to prison.

Four basic principles of firearm handling:

- 1) Treat every firearm as if it is loaded.
- 2) Never point a firearm at anything you are not willing to destroy.

 3) Keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to fire.
- 4) Always be sure of your target and what is beyond it.

You are responsible for the safe use and operation of all firearms in your possession or that you come in contact with. Always check to make sure the firearm is unloaded. Check the chamber, receiver, and magazine to be certain they do not contain any ammunition. Never assume the firearms is unloaded. Always check for yourself.

Use of a firearm under any circumstance may be dangerous. SERIOUS INJURY OR EVEN DEATH may result without proper training in the safe handling of firearms. Proper training should be obtained from an accredited firearms safety program conducted by competent, qualified instructors in the military, police academies or National Rifle Association affiliated instruction programs.

DO NOT OPERATE ANY FIREARMS WHILE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS.

Ensure that your firearm is in a safe overall working condition prior to performing this upgrade.




Keep all small parts out of the reach of children. They are a choking hazard.


Be sure that all parts are connected and all fasteners tightened correctly before firing your rifle.



- Thread in buffer tube into rear of the receiver until it stops. Check to see if the notch cut into the threads of the buffer tube is aligned with the set screw hole on the bottom of the receiver. If it is not, unthread the buffer tube until it is aligned and insert set screw (E) using a 5/64" hex head until it is hand tight*. Then tighten the castle nut using a castle nut wrench.
 - * Hand tight is defined as: the maximun torque you can apply to the set screw using only your handstrength without causing damage to set screw or receiver threads.
